3. Important Dates:

Start date for online Registration : Monday, 17th February'2020

Last date for online Registration : Friday, 01st May'2020 Written Test & Personal Interview : Saturday, 09th May'2020

- **4.** Eligibility criteria: (Fulfillment of all / applicable conditions mandatory)
- 4.1 The candidate must be a graduate in any stream from a recognized University and should have obtained a minimum of 60% aggregate marks.
- 4.2 Candidate must have passed Mathematics or Statistics in 10+2 or equivalent examination **AND** at the Graduation level.
- 4.3 Candidates should mention in the online registration / e-admission form (if selected) all the subjects which the candidate has taken & appeared for (not best of four, five, six or seven). The candidate shall have passed all the subjects which he / she has taken & appeared for in the applicable examination/s. The aggregate percentage of all subjects which the candidate has taken & appeared for will be taken into consideration for confirming the eligibility of the candidate for the program at the time of admission.
- 4.4 In case the mark sheet issued by applicable board / University is in percentile/s or Grade point the actual aggregate percentage of all subjects appeared by the candidate will be taken into consideration.
- 4.5 Candidate awaiting the results of the final year examination may also apply.
- 4.6 Candidates called for admission on the basis of merit list and who do not have final mark sheet will be given "provisional admission". Fees will be accepted from such candidates but their admission will be confirmed on submission of final mark sheet.

- 4.7 Candidate whose final mark sheet is not available at the time of admission is required to upload internet copy of result duly attested by Principal of the school / college with official seal, failing which candidate will not be admitted for the program
- 4.8 Submission of AIU equivalence certificate to confirm the eligibility for the program is mandatory for those candidates who have completed their examination from Overseas Universities.
- 4.9 Candidates who have cleared their graduation by doing a part time course or through distance learning, correspondence course externally, open school from a recognized University are eligible to apply & register as per UGC guidelines.

5. Admission Process:

5.1 Online Registration & Payment of Registration:

- Before filling the online form, please read all the instructions carefully mentioned in the instruction sheet, important dates and also Terms & Condition given in the online application form.
 - Online Registration Fee of Rs.1800/- plus applicable taxes (Please refer online registration for payment details.)
 - Registration Fee is non-refundable.

5.2 Call Letter:

- Candidates who are registered successfully will be called for Written Test & Personal Interview. On the basis of information indicated in the Application Form, call letter for personal interview & venue will be communicated to the candidate as per important dates through the NMIMS website.
- Candidates are required to download the call letter from our website www.nmims.edu
 and upload below mentioned document. No separate call letter will be mailed or posted to
 the candidates.

Personal Interview : Maximum Marks: 20

- Final merit list will be prepared on the basis of the marks obtained in the Written Test & Personal Interview.
- Admission offer is given as per merit and vacancy. WAITLISTED candidates have to
 check their merit list status as per date given on the website. SELECTED candidate
 should upload necessary required document at the link provided in the admission offer
 letter, and after verification of the uploaded documents; the candidate will get the
 payment link (RTGS / NEFT details) for the payment of course fees within the stipulated
 time frame.
- The selection will be solely based on merit.
- The cut-off for deciding the merit shall lie solely with NMIMS.

7. Program Fees for batch 2019: (for information only)

Program fees for 1st year M. Sc. Economics were Rs.2,01,500/-

Fees for 1st year M.Sc. Economics (Batch 2020–22) will be declared at the time of admission.

8. Refund Rule:

If a student chooses to withdraw from the program of study in which he / she is enrolled, the institution concerned shall follow the following five-tier system for the refund of fees remitted by the student.

In case of (1) in the table above, the deduction will be 5% of the fees paid as processing charges from the refundable amount, subject to a maximum of Rs 5,000/-.
